Expectations

Being on the media team is a very active and fast-paced role. You will be tasked with documenting the whole event! Whether it be team breakfasts, high-energy worship, chilling out in the cafe or a flying tent; if it happens on-site we want you to capture it! Amongst the teams you will take turns to have mornings and evenings off, ensuring that you all are able to rest but most importantly, have fun serving!

What you need - Sadly Limitless doesn't have access to enough cameras for every person so a requirement for the team is that you are able to bring your own camera.

In addition to your specific roles all team members are asked to take responsibility for the wellbeing and safety of young people and follow emergency protocols as needed.

Hours – All teams work on a shift pattern, you will either work a morning, afternoon or evening shift, no more than 8 hours a day.

Minimum Age: 16

DBS Required: Yes

Reference: Every volunteer is required to have had a reference by someone who has had leadership responsibility for them for at least a year. This ideally needs to be a church leader, youth worker but also can be a work manager or teacher.
